Prepare a Halloween accessory (such as a medallion, mask, or hat) based on a person who has accomplishments in Computer Science theory. Some names are Backus, Blum, Cantor, Chomsky, Godel, Greibach, Karp, Kleene, Knuth, Markov, Myhill, Papadimitriou, Rice, Sudkamp (your textbook's author), or Turing. You have to clearly mark who the person is and turn it in class (see below for details).

There are two simple but important rules:

- 1. The person has to be outside of Michigan Tech.
- 2. Anything that belittles the person; depicts sex, drugs, or violance; or would not be considered as "G-rated" is not allowed.

Please turn in

- The accessory with your name behind it. If there is no space to put a name, please send me an e-mail message that describes your accessory and also make sure I mark it in class. I need your name to be able to give you the points for the homeworks.
- A short description that fits on a 3×5 area. The description tag should include:
 - The name of the person.
 - A description of the person's contribution to theoretical Computer Science.
 - A description of why you chose that person.

The accessories may be displayed with their accompanying tags at one of the department displays. Your name does not have to be on the displayed item.
